Professor Dr. CHEN Xin, Deputy Director of the Institute of European Studies at Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, and the Executive President and Managing Director of China-CEE Institute, a new think tank registered at Budapest in April 2017. From October 2008 to August 2021, Professor Dr. CHEN was elected to the Secretary General position by the Board of the Chinese Association of European Studies (CAES). Since September 2021, he is the deputy chair of the Chinese Association of European Studies. He is also an Executive member of Chinese Association on International Economic Relations. His research areas include European Economy, China-EU trade and economic relations, Central East European Studies.
